Subject: NLEM, 2015 formulations under provisions of DPCO, 2013 (Consolidated list as on 06.01.2017).


With reference to the above since AIOCD (Pharmatrac) is not capturing the PTR & MAT of these formulations, all the concerned manufacturers / marketing companies are requested to furnish the Price to Retailer (PTR) and Moving Annual Turnover (MAT) in value terms, duly self attested with proper authorized signature & seal of the authorized officer of the company, for the following formulations as mentioned in NLEM, 2015 revised Schedule - I i.e. Annexure - I and Annexure - II for the month of August 2015, by 20.01.2017, for enabling NPPA to take appropriate action for ceiling price fixation under provisions of DPCO, 2013.

Such request from the manufacturers/marketing companies has not been positively responded. Failing to get market data, NPPA will have no option but to proceed for price fixation of these formulations exercising extraordinary options under DPCO, 2013.
