Minutes of the 133rd & 1st meeting of Authority under DPCO 2013 held on 12th June, 2013 at 11.30 A.M.

Agenda Item no. 1

1. Members of the Authority who participated in the 132nd Meeting of the Authority confirmed the minutes of the 132nd meeting.
2. **Action Taken Report:** Noted

The attention of the Authority was drawn to the decision taken in its last meeting held on 16.05.2013 to refer the approved price fixation cases under DPCO 1995 to Department of Pharmaceuticals before they are notified in view of the announcement of DPCO 2013 on 15.05.2013. It was informed that the matter was referred to Department of Pharmaceuticals and they have given their advice, a copy of which was also placed before the Authority. The Authority was informed that the NPPA has notified the prices vide S.O. 1492(E) to 1502(E) after obtaining advice from Department of Pharmaceuticals, as decided by the Authority in its last meeting.

The Authority had detailed deliberations regarding the price fixation of scheduled formulations under DPCO, 2013 relating to 199 items proposed in the Agenda.


As explained in the Agenda, it was also informed in the meeting that the data provided by IMS-Health has been considered after clubbing the MAT value of specific medicines manufactured by the same company in different brand names/generic names for determining the market share (of more than or equal to 1%) for working

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out the ceiling prices. It was further brought to the notice of the Authority that though the data provided by IMS-Health consists of fewer brands in quite a few cases, more number of brands/products are available on the market. It was also noted by the Authority that though some details are available in the internet, basic requirement for price fixation like, 'Price to the Retailer (PTR)', 'MAT value' of the brand/product are not readily available. It was also observed that the data provided by the IMS-Health is not comprehensively covering all the brands/generic medicines available in the market and, therefore, it may not be possible to conclusively assume that the market share derived from the IMS-Health data is accurate and final. It was informed to the Authority that NPPA is also in the process of collecting information directly from the manufacturers/marketing companies with regard to the details of PTR, MAT value of the NLEM products etc. It was also clarified that since the present approach for determining the ceiling prices will benefit the consumers by putting a cap on the prices, beyond which no manufacturer can sell the medicines in the market, the task assumes urgency. After detailed discussion, the Authority directed that as per the provisions contained in para 9 of DPCO 2013, initially the ceiling price may be determined based on the data provided by IMS-Health. After completion of the initial pricing exercise, the ceiling prices may be duly verified with the data collected by NPPA and wherever it is required under extraordinary circumstances and in the larger public interest, the price revisions may be carried out as per the provisions contained in para 19 of DPCO 2013 with the prior approval of the Authority.

Subject to the above observations, the Authority approved the prices as proposed in the Agenda. While approving the proposal of ceiling price fixation, the Authority also directed that another verification and check may be carried out before notifying the same.

3. The Authority was informed about the medicines under Schedule-I of DPCO 2013 which were also part of the Scheduled Drugs under DPCO 1995 which do not require price fixation at this juncture pursuant to the provisions as in para 10(1) & 10(2) of DPCO 2013. Accordingly, it was decided that a general instruction may be



put up on the official website containing the complete list of DPCO 1995 Scheduled drugs covered under DPCO 2013, directing all concerned to effect any change in the price of the respective medicine if required, in accordance with the provisions contained in para 10(1) and 10(2) of DPCO 2013.

4. The Authority considered the draft notification to be issued for notifying the prices approved by the Authority and approved the same with minor corrections.

5. The Chairman NPPA, also emphasised for the early price fixation under DPCO 2013 in order to pass on the benefits of the formulation prices to the consumer at large. The Authority decided that the next meeting of the NPPA may be held on 21.06.2013 followed by another meeting on 28.06.2013 to complete the task of price fixation under DPCO 2013 at the earliest. The meeting concluded with vote of thanks to the Chair.

6. A Statement showing the prices approved and percentage of decrease from the highest price in the zone of consideration in respect of each medicine is enclosed which is a part of the minutes.
