Subject: Minutes of the 18th meeting of Multidisciplinary Committee of Experts held on 08.05.2020 at 11:00 AM in NPPA

18th meeting of the "Multidisciplinary Committee of Experts" was held on 08.05.2020 under the Convenorship of the Sh. N.I. Chowdhury, Adviser (Cost), in the Conference Room of NPPA. The following members attended the meeting through video conferencing:-

Agenda No. I Retail price fixation of Syrup in which each 15 ml syrup containing Ferric Ammonium Citrate IP 160mg, Vitamin B12 IP 5mcg , Folic Acid IP 1 mg , Zinc Sulphate Monohydrate IP 30mg under Para 5 of DPCO, 2013 for M/s Zydus Healthcare Ltd (marketer) and M/s Zydus Healthcare Ltd (manufacturer/ importer)
- I.I The Committee observed that the representative of the office of DCGI clarified that the subject formulation is approved by DCGI on 03.02.2016 under 18 month policy (Kokate Committee rational FDC List) decision.
- I.2 The deliberated upon the matter in detail and decided to calculate the price of the syrup by taking available data as per Pharmatrac for the month of May 2019 in respect of syrup having ferrous combinations with ferrous strength of 160 mg under para 4 of DPCO 2013. The calculation came to Rs. 0.50 per ml and accordingly the Committee recommended the retail of syrup containing Ferric Ammonium Citrate IP 160mg, Vitamin B12 IP 5mcg, Folic Acid IP I mg, Zinc Sulphate Monohydrate IP 30mg under Para 5 of DPCO, 2013 for M/s Zydus Healthcare Ltd (marketer) and M/s Zydus Healthcare Ltd (manufacturer/ importer) at Rs. 0.50 per ml excluding GST.
- 2. Agenda No. 2 Retail price fixation of Docaravimab and Miromavimab combination Injections under Para 5 of DPCO, 2013 for M/s Cadila Healthcare Ltd (marketer) and M/s Cadila Healthcare Ltd (manufacturer/ importer)
- 2.1 The Committee noted that applicant company has claimed the retail price for various packs and strength of Docaravimab and Miromavimab combination Injections as detailed below:

- 2.2 M/s Cadila Healthcare Ltd made a presentation before the Committee. The Committee deliberated upon the matter in detail and observed that the novel cocktails of two murine monoclonal anti-bodies namely Docaravimab and Miromavimab is used against rabies as Antirabies Immunoglobulin and the same are approved by DCGI as an Investigational New Drug (IND). IND Committee constituted at ICMR has vetted the result of comparative phase 3 clinical trial with Human rabies Immunoglobulin (HRI) and found the results acceptable and recommended for marketing authorization. Accordingly, based on the recommendation of IND, DCGI has issued the necessary permission in Form 46.
- 2.3 The committee observed the justification of price submitted by company based on therapeutic benchmark cum incremental innovation and recommended the retail price as detailed below:
