The undersigned is directed to refer to NPPA's OM of even number dated  $25^{th}$  September, 2017 conveying the decision of the Authority under Para 21(2) to allow withdrawal of Xience Alpine brand of coronary stent in a period of one year from the date of issue of public notice by M/s. Abbott Healthcare Pvt. Ltd.

- 2. Subsequent to the issue of the above OM, the Department of Pharmaceuticals vide Order No.31026/05/2017-Pricing dated 27th September, 2017 invoked the powers of Section 3 (i) of DPCO,2013 and directed companies manufacturing coronary stents to maintain uninterrupted supply of coronary stents for three months from the date of notification. Therefore, the order dated 27th September, 2017 issued by the Department of Pharmaceuticals supersedes the OM dated 25th September, 2017 issued by NPPA and makes it null and void.
